# Staffing Update for Term 2

A note went home recently to inform you of some staffing updates for Term 2. We have been working on a staffing plan that will best support the learning and wellbeing needs of all our students, preschool to Year 6. Mrs Lyndal Thomas will be returning to Broke Public School in her capacity as a permanent classroom teacher from Term 2. Mrs Tina Fahey has also received a permanent position at another school. From Term 2, class organisation will be as follows:

### Wombats Preschool:

Mrs Noni Anderiesen will be teaching the Wombats preschool for the remainder of 2024. From Term 2, our preschool will operate on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays to accommodate this change. Mrs Anderiesen will be spending time with Mrs Fahey on a handover to ensure smooth transition for our Wombats students. We anticipate this will be the only change in operation for our preschool program this year.

We wish Mrs Fahey all the best for her permanent position and thank her for her care of our Wombats during her time at Broke.

#### K-6 classes:

Mrs Lyndal Thomas will be returning to Broke in her capacity as a permanent staff member from Term 2. Mrs Thomas is known to all our students, having taught K-6 last year. She brings with her expertise in STEM and digital technologies, valuable tools for all our students to learn and experience. As such, Mrs Thomas will be working in both classrooms from Term 2.

NSW Department of Education is delivering on a commitment to improve policies and reduce administrative workload so teachers can spend more time with their students. All department policies have been reviewed to make them easier to read, understand, and interpret.

The first batch of policies and procedures have been published in the Policy Library. The policies include:

- Aboriginal education
- Commercial arrangements, sponsorship and donations
- Inclusive education for students with disability
- School attendance
- Selective high school and opportunity class placement
- Sharing of school facilities
- Technology in schools
- Improvements to policy documents

There are minimal changes to these policy documents, with no change to the overall intent. Schools won't need to create additional local instructions to comply with policy as all requirements will be available in the Policy Library.
